These responses contributed to shared definitions of bullying.</p> <p>Nottingham as a city of sanctuary. What does it mean for a city, schools and its citizens to create a place of welcome? Pupils work on transferring their ideas to ceramic tiles, which will be displayed in the Market Square this summer.</p> <p>A group of pupils requested opportunities to engage with Warhammer (tabletop gaming/model painting). This led to a lunchtime club being set up and an unused room being made into the 'Warhammer Room'.</p>
Summer Term	Pupil Council  Primary Parliament  Global Voices	Whole school/selected pupils  Class 3  Pathway 2 pupils	<p>The whole school engaged in activities including campaigns and elections to select representatives from each class to take part in pupil council. They will meet regularly and undertake project work. The council supported recent teacher recruitment by devising questions and interviewing candidates. The council shared their views on plans for developing the outdoor learning area.</p> <p>The class took part in creative activities, sharing a performance with other schools.</p> <p>Focus on gardening and the importance of growing plants. Pupils shared their experiences of growing plans though the allotment education project with other international schools.</p>
Ongoing	Lunchtime clubs	Whole school/selected pupils	<p>We have ongoing lunchtime clubs – Mental Health Support, 'Our Voice' and a girl's group which provide additional opportunities to capture pupil voice on and ad-hoc basis.</p>
